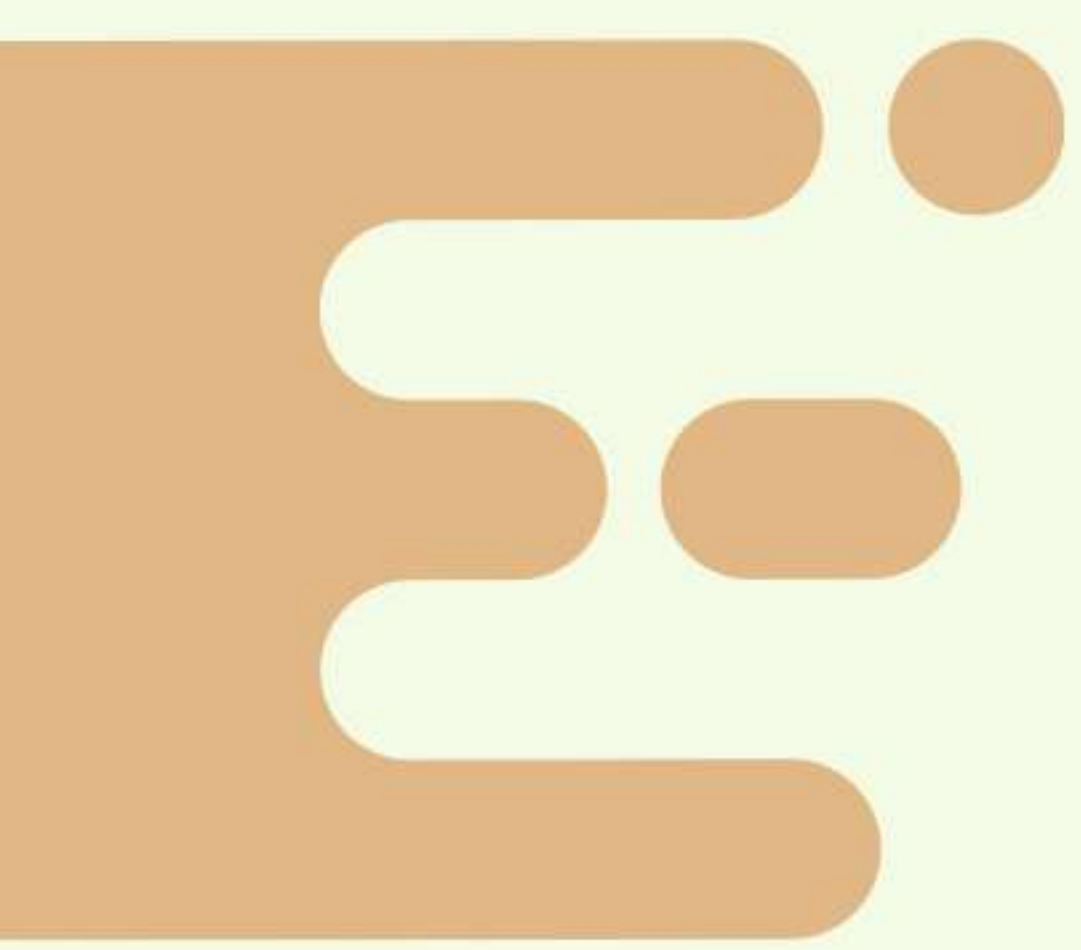
Hamza Iqbal

Frequently Asked Questions

Is ELF a train-the-trainer? Can I do it if I have not done a TTT before?

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ELF builds upon the foundational principles of teaching and training, and goes a step ahead in introducing a different style. Both existing trainers and those entirely new to the field of training can gain immensely from this approach.

Will the program cover all of the core contents of a conventional TTT program?

There are many variations of TTT programs. All employ different methodologies and varying depths. ELF will emphasize shifting from a trainer to a facilitator mindset, which has its own unique set of skills parallel to a conventional TTT, but not exactly the same.

Is this a residential program? Setting?

The program is a resort based, 3 days and 2 nights program. We start in the afternoon on Day 1, and end in the evening on Day 3. It will be held in the Galiat region.

What experience do you have in training using the experiential learning methodology?

In the last 20 years, Training Impact has pioneered unique experiential approaches to training corporate executives in leadership, team work, decision making, ethics and many other areas.
